Notification pursuant to the LPSC's 2011 Net Metering Order (R-31417)

Dear Secretary Gonzalez:

I am submitting this letter to you as regulatory counsel for Panola-Harrison Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Panola-Harrison"), pursuant to Section 5.02(A) of the LPSC's General Order dated July 22, 2011, Docket No. R-31417, *In re: Re-examination of the Commission's Net Energy Metering Rules found in General Order No. R-27558, dated November 30, 2005 (the "Net Metering Order")*. This order, hereinafter referred to as the "2011 Net Metering Order," requires LPSC-regulated electric utilities to notify the Commission when the utility's net metering purchases exceed .5% of the utility's LPSC-jurisdictional peak load. By this letter, I am notifying you that, by our calculations, Panola-Harrison appears to have exceeded .5% of its LPSC-jurisdictional peak load in net metering purchases.

Section 5.02(A) of the 2011 Net Metering Order also appears to require the utility providing this notification to also request a suspension of the Commission's Louisiana Net Metering Rules along with this notification. In addition to a requested suspension of the Louisiana Net Metering Rules required by Section 5.02(A), Section 5.02(B) of the 2011 Net Metering Order provides that all future net metering applications be suspended until the Commission has an opportunity to revisit the net metering rule to consider the impact of widespread distributed self-generated power. Finally, Section 5.02(B) also provides that the claims of a utility providing this notification will be subject to verification by the Commission.

Considering that the Commission is scheduled to assess and possibly clarify the directive for further action for utilities who exceed .5% of their LPSC-jurisdictional peak load, and pending verification of Panola-Harrison's calculations by the Commission, Panola-Harrison will

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hold any new net metering applications in abeyance until the Commission directs Panola-Harrison to take other action.
